Stage 1: Criteria for people who want to teach the Certificate of Clinical Reflexology:

- Diploma or Professional Certificate of Reflexology from RAoA recognised School/College.
- At least three years experience as a Professional Reflexologist.
- CV of experience as a Professional Reflexologist
- Three years as a Professional Member of the Reflexology Association of Australia or a parallel Professional Association.
- Current Certificate IV in Training and Assessment – currently TAE40116
- Certificate of Police Clearance
- Desirable:** Partnership with RTO will be looked at favourably (enabling students to continue studies to Diploma level), but not essential.
- Desirable:** Working with Children Card, as you may have students under 18 years of age.

Once this information is received you will receive an acknowledgement that the material has been received.

If you have the required qualifications you will be notified and you may apply to teach the RAoA CoCR and be accredited as a CoCR school.

Stage 2: Application Form 2 will be emailed to you upon successfully passing the criteria required. Further evidence, documentation and payment is required at this stage.
