Why undertake CPT?

CPT provides a simple assessable means where members can provide evidence of having undertaken annual further training since graduation. It is recognised as having updated clinical skills and professional knowledge in line with current practice. CPT programs are an expectation of professional life. It is one thing to become a Professional, it is another thing to remain a Professional.

What are the benefits of CPT?

Completing the CPT program ensures annual attainment of Professional Membership, which then ensures:

- Recognition as a Professional Practitioner
- o Provider number status from health funds that rebate for Reflexology
- Access to official RAoA receipt books
- Competitive rates for professional indemnity and public liability insurance through insurance companies associated with RAoA
- Listing on the national:

RAoA Register RAoA Website Telephone referral service

What are the Requirements?

Professional Membership as outlined by the RAoA Constitution requires the maintenance of current senior first aid, indemnity and public liability insurance as well as evidence of Continuing Professional Training. Professional members must accumulate a minimum of 20 CPT points per annum commencing 1 July to 30 June.

Extension of time from the CPT program:

An extension of time to gain CPT points may be considered on application. Contact the Membership Officer for an application form.

CPT Recording Procedure

Members can record their annual CPT activities via the CPT Tracker on the RAoA website. Members must log in first to complete the activities. To view instruction on how to use the CPT Tracker, click on "How to track your CPT on-line" icon.

To record your CPT on-line, click on "Track your CPT on-line" icon. All the activities are dated and recorded in correct Activity order.

Alternatively CPT can be recorded on the hardcopy 'CPT Program' document found under "Browse all CPT Documentation" icon.

Audits and Evidence of CPT Activities

The RAoA reserves the right to audit the CPT activities claimed for Professional Membership, as do the Private Health Funds. Audit are conducted annually. You must have and keep evidence for all CPT activities that you record. *Please refer to the FAQ document on the RAoA website with all other CPT Documents, for the information on type of evidence required.*
